WAYNE MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEM, INC. After a cardiac event, many physicians refer their patients to a Cardiac Rehabilitation program to help them learn how to return to healthy and productive lifestyles. Cardiac events include heart attack, bypass and valve surgery, angioplasty with a stent, heart transplant, stable angina or other complications of cardiac disease, The Cardiac Rehabilitation professionals at Wayne Memorial Hospital are committed to improving the lives and health of their patients through exercise and education within a Three Phase Program.

PHASE I

Phase I is delivered in an inpatient setting where you receive bedside education about diet modification and exercise. After you are discharged, you need a physician's prescription to continue with Phase II of Cardiac Rehabilitation.

PHASE II

Phase II consists of 36 sessions of education and monitored exercise designed to meet your personal health goals. At your first Phase II session the cardiac rehab team will take your medical history, evaluate your physical condition and administer a six-minute walk test. After your initial assessment you will receive a personalized exercise program approved by your referring physician. This program, three days a week over the course of 12 weeks, is supervised by an exercise physiologist and cardiac rehab nurse. To help reduce your risk for future cardiac problems, you may also receive helpful information regarding lifestyle changes, such as changes in your diet, your exercise routine, smoking cessation, medication intake, stress management, diabetes and hypertension management.

PHASE III

Upon completion of Phase II you are eligible to participate in the Cardiac Rehabilitation Department's Maintenance Program. This twice-weekly exercise program is designed to help you maintain the gains achieved during Phase II. During this stage your Rehab team will continue to modify your exercise program to suit your physical needs and reinforce your plan to take control of risk factors.



APPOINTMENTS:

A physician's prescription is required before beginning your Cardiac Rehabilitation program. To schedule an appointment call the Cardiac Rehabilitation Office at (570) 253-8253. We make every effort to honor time commitments and request that you extend the same courtesy to us. Please call to cancel a scheduled appointment.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

The Cardiac Rehabilitation Department is open Monday through Friday, alternating days for the Phase II and Maintenance programs.
