## <u>Leaves from my Journal</u> Sheila Vaswani

When you enter his presence you will encounter a mild mannered, well-spoken, bespectacled, white haired gentleman who appears most thoughtful. This is not the stereotype of the engineer that one expects to meet but this is John Conti and he is the engineer responsible for the new construction at Wayne Memorial Hospital.

I interviewed him in early January to get his take on what the new construction would entail, what upheaval it might involve and what benefit would accrue to our community. He was forthright, totally unguarded and perfectly frank in his observations.

He spoke of the challenges we can expect. There will be radical change for approximately one year. The present parking lot will be leveled and the front of the hospital will be unavailable. No one likes change and no one likes to encounter the unexpected especially when journeying to a hospital, which often involves a stressful situation anyway.

However Mr. Conti assures us that signage will be plentiful, clear and ubiquitous. Additionally, the Emergency Room will be open, untouched and available in its accustomed place to drop off patients. Furthermore, social media, the newspapers, radio, church bulletins, etc. will be announcing the forthcoming changes and how to circumvent any obstacles one may incur. So dear readers, all will be new, and perhaps initially disconcerting but in the final analysis, all will be well.

A query that I had for Mr. Conti that he readily answered was needless to say what good will come of all this upheaval. The following was his response I put it in outline form for easy readability and the information comes under the rubrics of privacy, safety, staff safety, and new technology.

- 1. Fifty -new private rooms will be installed at the hospital. Recently promulgated new privacy laws have mandated that semi-private rooms can no longer be constructed due to privacy concerns and fears of the spread of infection to another patient.
- 2. New ceiling rails and a state of the art lifting system will be mounted in each room so that patients can be moved without threat of injury to the staff.
- 3. Telemedicine will make available to each patient and physician a specialist via the computer. Lastly, the Internet will be available in each patient room.

So dear readers, fear not change, embrace the future and in the parlance of the streets, go with the flow because the end result will be well worth a bit of short-term discombobulating. Have no fear, John Conti is here and we can all take great comfort in that.
