overall health of a rural community, as the place to go for injury and illness, as well as an employer and collaborator with the local education system and local government. Therefore, he freely volunteered his time and wisdom as Chief of the Medical Staff and a member of the Board of Trustees of Wayne Memorial Hospital for more than 43 years from his initial appointment in 1957 until his death in 2001.

The Harry D. Propst, MD, Sporting Clays Invitational enters its 12th year. As always, funds raised will be used to support the provision of the highest quality healthcare services possible throughout Wayne Memorial Health System. Wayne Memorial Hospital's new 85,000 square foot Patient Tower--housing 50 private patient rooms is near completion. The new wing includes a state-of-the-art nurse call system, whiteboards that display the names of providers entering the room and TV sets with apps ranging from NetFlix to patient education. On June 5, 2019 the first patient was welcomed to her private room on the 4th floor while the new Same Day Recovery unit opened on the 2nd floor. The 3rd Floor was ready for patients soon after, opening on June 11th. Various areas in the existing space have also been renovated. The main floor will soon have a modern look as updated flooring is installed and an enclosed pedestrian concourse connecting the new lobby to the previous lobby area and Emergency Department is fabricated. The celebration culminates on September 7th with a Community Open House. Facility improvements and continuous commitment to exceptional patient care will set the stage for Wayne Memorial Hospital's Centennial in the year 2020. - 1. Follow Route 191 north to village of Lookout approximately 26 miles from Honesdale
- 2. At Lookout General Store (on left) turn right onto Braman Road
- 3. Proceed on Braman Road approximately 6 miles until you reach the one-lane bridge
- 4. Cross bridge into New York and proceed approximately .05 mile to the "T" intersection
- 5. Make left onto NY-97 and continue approximately 1.5 miles
- 6. Make right onto County Road 134 immediately after crossing viaduct. Stone shamrock and signs for Catskill Pheasantry in the side of the hill.
- 7. Make first right onto Basket Road, approximately 1.5 miles. Follow Catskill Pheasantry sign.
- 8. Continue on Basket Road approximately 2 miles.
- 9. Make left onto Neer Road—Catskill Pheasantry sign on tree.
- 10. Follow Neer Road .75 mile to Catskill Pheasantry.
