

UPDATED VISITOR POLICY

Hospital Inpatients

Visitors are allowed in these circumstances, effective June 17, 2020.

Non-COVID-19 medical/surgical patients

• Labor & Delivery, New Beginnings

• Infant/Pediatric patients

• Non-Covid-19 Patient in an end-of-life situation

• Covid-19 Patient in an end-of-life situation

Patient who requires informed clinical-consent

• Patient who needs discharge support

Hospital Outpatient Procedures

• Emergency Department

• Inpatient Rehabilitation (Good Shepherd)

• Swing Bed Patients

1 healthy and designated visitor

1 support person

1 set of parents or authorized representative

2 healthy and designated visitors

2 healthy and designated visitors – must be able to wear required PPE (personal protective equipment)

1 designated person essential to care

1 healthy and designated visitor

1 healthy support person

1 healthy support person

1 healthy person at a time

1 healthy and designated visitor

All visitors must follow these guidelines for infection control

- Visitation hours (where allowed) 9am to 6pm
- COVID-19 in end-of-life situation: patient visitation may be more restricted in time allowances
- No visitors under 18 years of age with exceptions
- Visitors will have their temperature taken and be screened upon entry to the hospital
- Visitors must wear a face mask inside the hospital
- Visitors are allowed to stay in the patient's room only and should not visit any other areas of the hospital

Visitor Restrictions in these areas

Intensive Care unit
No visitors except in special circumstances

Same-Day Surgery
1 healthy designated visitor restricted to

waiting/recovery areas

• Wayne Woodlands Manor No visitors except in end-of-life situations
