

# **UPDATED VISITOR POLICY**

## **Hospital Inpatients**

#### Visitors are allowed in these circumstances, effective June 17, 2020.

- Non-COVID-19 medical/surgical patients
- Labor & Delivery, New Beginnings
- Infant/Pediatric patients
- Non-Covid-19 Patient in an end-of-life situation
- Covid-19 Patient in an end-of-life situation
- Patient who requires informed clinical consent
- Patient who needs discharge support
- Hospital Outpatient Procedures
- Emergency Department
- Inpatient Rehabilitation (Good Shepherd)
- Swing Bed Patients

healthy and designated visitor
support person
set of parents or authorized representative
healthy and designated visitors
healthy and designated visitors – must be able to
wear required PPE (personal protective equipment)
designated person essential to care
healthy and designated visitor
healthy support person
healthy support person
healthy person at a time
healthy and designated visitor

### All visitors must follow these guidelines for infection control

- Visitation hours (where allowed) 9am to 6pm
- COVID-19 in end-of-life situation: patient visitation may be more restricted in time allowances
- No visitors under 18 years of age with exceptions
- Visitors will have their temperature taken and be screened upon entry to the hospital
- Visitors must wear a face mask inside the hospital
- Visitors are allowed to stay in the patient's room only and should not visit any other areas of the hospital

#### **Visitor Restrictions in these areas**

- Intensive Care unit
- Same-Day Surgery
- Wayne Woodlands Manor

No visitors except in special circumstances 1 healthy designated visitor restricted to waiting area No visitors except in end-of-life situations
