Recommendations made by a Blue Ribbon committee on which Frank served were prominent in the Sarbanes Oxley bill passed by Congress relating to Corporate Finance and Governance. Frank was appointed by former Federal Reserve Chair Paul Volker to the Interim Advisory Committee to improve internal procedures of auditing firms. Frank was Chairman of the Board of the Financial Executives International (FEI) and a key member of the FEI Task Force to improve Financial Management, Financial Reporting and Corporate Governance.

Frank has also been very active in a number of other organizations, including chair or board member of the New York and National Multiple Sclerosis Society, St. Thomas Aquinas College, Good Samaritan Hospital, Rockland Paramedics and Dominican College.
