All visitors must follow these guidelines for infection control

- Visitation hours (where allowed) 9am to 6pm.
- End of Life COVID-19 patient visitation may be more restricted in time allowances.
- No visitors under 18 years of age with exceptions.
- Visitors will have their temperature taken and be screened upon entry to the hospital.
- Visitors must wear a face mask inside the hospital.
- Visitors, please stay in the patient's room only and do not visit any other areas of the hospital.
- Visitors who do not comply with Wayne Memorial safety protocols, such as masking, will lose their visiting privileges.
